# Step 1: Start Planning

- Look at the picture what is happening in this picture?
- How can you connect the picture to the headline?
- In your rough notes, answer some or all of the following questions: who, what, where, when, why, how?
- Then add: quotes, more information
- Think of a catchy lead paragraph

### Step 2: Create a Story!

- Write a byline
- Create a catchy lead paragraph
- Write in the 3rd person
- Write the body (1-3 paragraphs)
- Be sure to include a quotation
- Print neatly and legibly

# Review/Edit

#### Checklist:

- Is the article related to the headline?
- Are all 5W's present?
- Is enough detail used?
- Is there a quotation used?
- Did you use third person narration?
- Are 4-5 paragraphs used?
- Is there a byline?
- Is there a good lead paragraph?




